Year 2012 Name of Activity: Internship Program

R.P. Broadcasting currently has an internship program in association with Bemidji State University's (BSU) Mass Communication Department. BSU's Mass Communication Departments trains students for careers in the field of radio, television and journalism. R.P. Broadcasting management has developed a professional relationship and internship program with professors in both colleges.

Year 2011-2012 Name of Activity: Participation in Four Educational **Institution Career Oriented Events**

R.P. Broadcasting Management consisting of Daniel J. Voss, General Manager has attended four events hosted by educational organizations promoting career opportunities in broadcasting. According to guidelines established by the FCC, this qualifies as needed outreach initiatives for stations KKBJ AM, KKBJ FM, and WBJI FM.

The first event attended was Career Connections held at Bemidji State University on March 22, 2011. The event allowed students at Bemidji State to explore and speak with management of RP Broadcasting about a career in the field of radio broadcasting. Since Bemidji State has an active Mass Communication Department, many students came to learn more about the field to help them determine a collegiate focus.

One event was a Job Fair was held at Bemidji State University on 11-25-12. Since the University has a Mass Communication Department with a Radio emphasis, this job fair allows prospective employers like R.P. Broadcasting the opportunity to speak with many students exploring the industry. The program also allows for the marketing of RP Broadcasting's Internship Program.

- R.P. Broadcasting's Manager, Daniel Voss meets with every Introduction to Radio class at Bemidji State University. He is invited in by the professors to allow students the opportunity to gain a better understanding of a career in broadcasting. Students attending this class come from all majors, including Mass Communication. Regardless of their major, all students gain a better understanding of career opportunities in radio. This program also includes a tour of the R.P. Broadcasting facilities.
- R.P. Broadcasting annually attends career day at The Bemidji Middle school to promote careers in broadcasting, specifically radio. The General Manager or Program director meet with approximately 50 students annually who are interested in a career in radio. Students are given the opportunity to ask questions regarding a career in radio, while R.P. Broadcasting staff members provide "A day in the life of an announcer." Students attending these sessions rate them as "informative" and "fun".

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Year 2011-2012 Name of Activity: Job Fair Co-Sponsorship
